Mozzarella from the irritating Italian Claudio, on the farm; veggies from Westmill, hairy Pete; Laverstoke buffaloes provide the ice cream when they can be bothered to let down their milk; other dairy products from Berkeley Farm, via Eastbrook; charcuterie from Native Breeds; asparagus in season from Lotmead; dry goods from the Stalinist Essential, whenever possible. Almost everything organic and/or Fairtrade. Except currently potatoes. Try the new rooms here. They are fun, and service levels can be epic, according to one or two reviews. Or rent the upstairs space for a party. Or the new Playroom, in the garden, for anything you want.
